Packing Checklist (Desert Hiking)

- 2–3 L water per person (half-day)
- 4-5+ L water per person (full-day)
- Electrolytes / salty snacks
- Sun hat + UV sunglasses
- Sunscreen SPF 30+ and SPF lip balm
- Lightweight long-sleeve sun shirt
- Trail shoes with grip (sticky rubber ideal)
- Hiking socks (wool/synthetic)
- Small first-aid kit + blister care
- Headlamp with fresh batteries
- Map + offline maps downloaded
- Portable charger + cable

- Trekking poles (optional)
- Light insulating layer
- Rain shell (monsoon months)
- Gloves for scrambles/rappels (if applicable)
- Emergency whistle + space blanket
- Multi-tool / knife
- Trash bag (leave no trace)
- Toilet kit (wag bag where required)
- Permit / pass / ID
- Cash for park fees
- Cooler & ice in vehicle
- Extra water jug in vehicle

Safety & Emergency Info

- Hydrate early and often; bring more water than you think you need.
- Avoid the hottest hours in summer; plan sunrise starts and midday shade.
- Flash flood risk is real in canyons during monsoon season; check forecasts.
- Stay on durable surfaces; cryptobiotic soil is fragile and alive.
- Tell someone your plan and expected return time, and check in after.
- Turn around before you are tired; save energy for the return.
