

# Devils Garden Campground – Quick Guide

The Devils Garden Campground is the only developed campground in Arches National Park. Located 18 miles from the park entrance, it offers 51 campsites surrounded by red sandstone fins and easy access to famous trails like Landscape Arch and Double O Arch.

## Best Time to Camp – Seasonal Overview

| Season           | Conditions             | Why Camp                          | Things to Watch Out For             |
|------------------|------------------------|-----------------------------------|-------------------------------------|
| Spring (Mar–May) | Mild days, cool nights | Best overall weather, wildflowers | Hardest to get reservations         |
| Summer (Jun–Aug) | Very hot (90–105°F)    | Stargazing, long daylight hours   | Extreme heat, thunderstorms         |
| Fall (Sep–Oct)   | Comfortable temps      | Golden light, excellent hiking    | Still busy, reservations needed     |
| Winter (Nov–Feb) | Cold, occasional snow  | Quiet, more availability          | Freezing nights, limited facilities |

- Reservations: Required March–October via Recreation.gov
- Price: \$25 per night (standard site)
- Pets: Allowed in campground, not on trails
- Facilities: Picnic tables, fire rings, drinking water (seasonal), flush toilets
- RVs: Up to 40 feet, no hookups
- Group Sites: 2 (by reservation)
